#### ACCREDITATION PRIOR TO CLOSURE:

Santa Fe University of Art and Design is also recognized by the New Mexico State Board of Education for teacher certification and approved for veterans' training.

#### NAME CHANGE:

On September 2, 2010, College of Santa Fe officially changed the institutional name to Santa Fe University of Art and Design. Upon the name change, any degree conferred or credit awarded prior to September 1, 2010 was officially recognized by Santa Fe University of Art and Design.

#### TRANSCRIPTS FROM SANTA FE UNIVERSITY OF ART AND DESIGN:

Santa Fe University of Art and Design maintains multiple student record systems. Transcripts from student records crossing multiple systems may appear in different formats.

#### RELEASE OF INFORMATION:

This educational record is subject to the Family Educational and Privacy Act (FERPA) of 1974. It is furnished for official use only and may not be released to or accessed by outside agencies or third parties without the written consent of the student concerned. Students may obtain copies of their academic records through the Office of the Registrar by written request only. All financial obligations to Santa Fe University of Art and Design must be fulfilled before an official transcript can be issued.

#### COURSE NUMBERING SYSTEM:

Courses numbered 0000-0099 are considered developmental and are not counted toward graduation requirements. Courses numbered 1000-2999 are considered lower-division courses and are open to all students of the Santa Fe University of Art and Design who have the necessary prerequisites. Courses numbered 3000-4999 are considered upper-division courses and are normally open to juniors and seniors. Other students may enroll in upper-division courses with the permission of the department chair. Courses numbered 5000-6999 are considered graduate courses and open only to students accepted in the respective program.

#### GRADES:

All credit hours earned are expressed in semester hours and are on a 4.0 grading system. A semester is 16-17 weeks in length. Santa Fe University of Art and Design utilizes a plus/minus grading system, based upon the grades in the table below. The grade point average is the weighted average of the quality points earned. Grades of "I", "P" and "W" carry no quality points and are not included in the grade point average.

#### GRADE MARKS AND GRADE OPTIONS:

All entries relating to grade marks as they appear on the transcript should be interpreted as follows:

A – Exceptional mastery, B – Above average mastery, C – Sufficient mastery, D – Below average mastery, F – Failure to meet minimal standards, CR – Credit, AC – Advanced Credit (Credit received through College Approved Testing and Programs e.g. CLEP, AP, DANTES), AU – No credit desired, I – Incomplete, N – Not complete (Student stopped attending without formal withdrawal), NR – Not reported by the instructor, P – Passing (courses graded with P count toward graduation but are not computed in the student's grade point average), W – Official withdrawal.

The grade point average (GPA) is the weighted average of the quality points earned. Quality points per semester hour are assigned to the grades as follows:

A = 4.0, A- = 3.66, B+ = 3.33, B = 3.00, B- = 2.66, C+ = 2.33, C = 2.00, C- = 1.66, D+ = 1.33, D = 1.00, D- = 0.66, F = 0.00.

#### COURSE REPEATS:

An "A" or "E" notation next to a course indicates this course has been repeated and is excluded from the GPA calculations. An "I" notation next to the course indicates this course has been repeated and is included in the GPA calculations

#### TRANSFER CREDIT ENTRIES:

This transcript represents the grade point average of academic work completed at Santa Fe University of Art and Design **ONLY**. Transfer credit is not computed in the student's grade point average; however, the grade point average of a transfer student determines the academic status at the time of admission.

#### SCHOLASTIC STATUS:

A student is in good academic standing unless the transcript indicates otherwise.
